

Computational Linguistics in Bulgaria (CLIB) is an international conference focused on exploring novel approaches and methods in computational linguistics and natural language processing (NLP). The conference places special emphasis on techniques applicable to small and low-resource languages such as Bulgarian, with the aim of addressing the disparities between large and small languages in language technologies.

A **Special Session on Wordnets, Framenets and Ontologies** will be held at CLIB 2026, bringing together researchers working on their principles, applications and interoperability.

Since 2024, the conference confers a **Best Paper Award** for outstanding research by a Master's or PhD student presented at the forum.
